#### **Noxious Weeds**

Every year the conservation district receives phone calls of producers/landowners who are not controlling their noxious weeds. Please be aware that noxious weeds need to be controlled in tree and grass plantings. There is a big difference between land that needs some spot spraying and areas that are neglected because you think it's "good habitat".

#### Site Preparations/Renovations

A well-prepared site will ensure greatest survivability of your trees and is easier on equipment. The district has the right to refuse to plant your site and down-payment will be forfeited if it is not adequately prepared. Each situation will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Having a well-prepared site and keeping the trees free of weeds will cut down on your replant costs. The district reserves the right to charge more for poorly prepared sites, and renovations at the discretion of the District Manager. If any doubt, just call Stephanie and she can take a look.

#### **Cost Share**

Limited cost share is available for shelterbelts through Conservation District partners. We have programs with cost share availability as well.
